- Finalist in the CIPR Pride Awards for best event “Safestore”



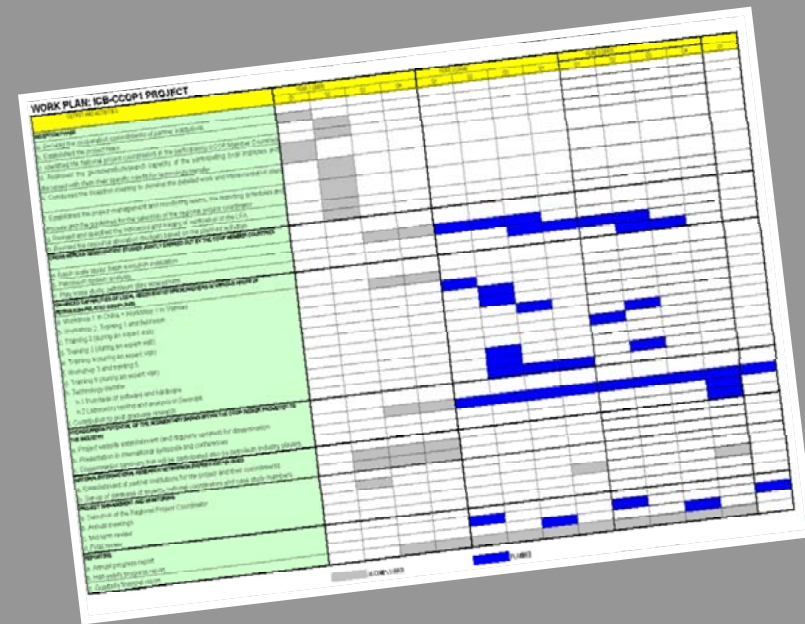

- Caesium removal plant

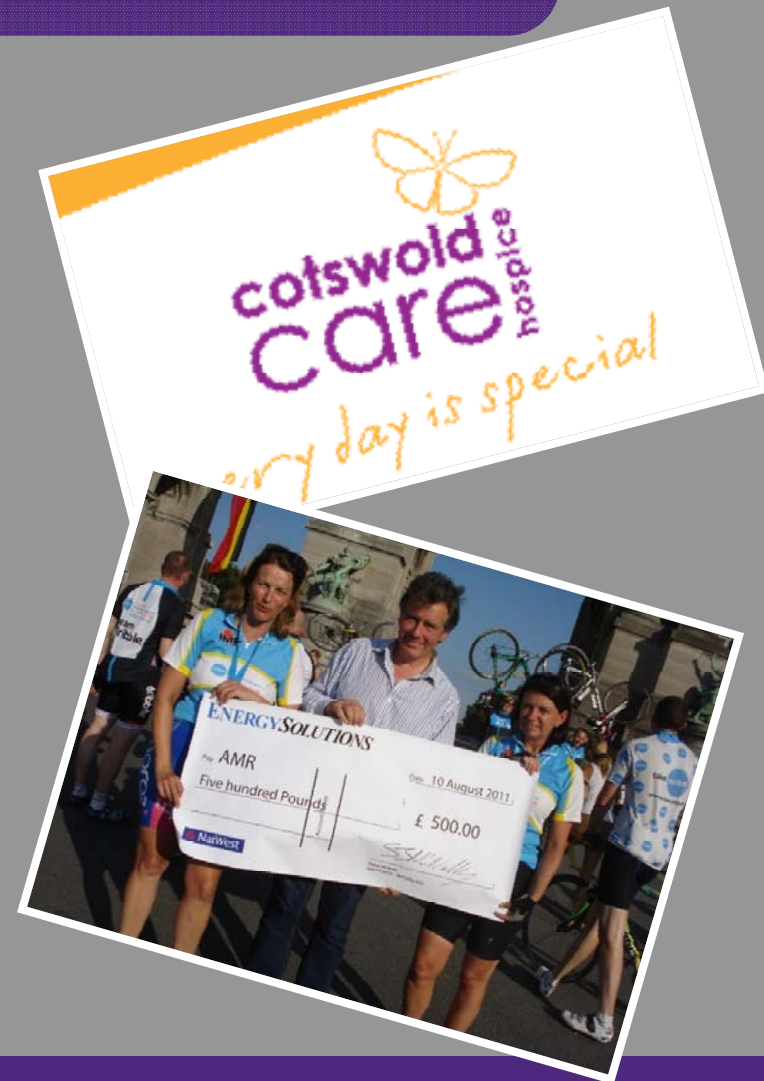

- Asset management



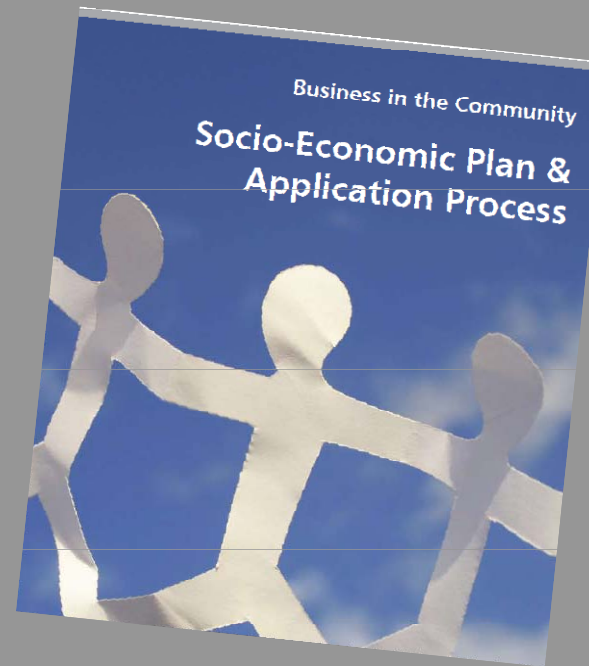
# Charity/Community
