End of Year Report

- All PBIs achieved on, or ahead of schedule.
- £855k cashable savings Value for Money (VfM) submitted to NDA.
- Excellent progress made on Reactor Preparations for entry into Safestore.
- The Shielded Area final pond drained, cleaned and securely capped.
- Completed £16.2m of project work with no major injuries.



Safety & Environmental Performance

- Excellent safety performance continued
- One RIDDOR Event (Falling from Vehicle during site exercise)
- The site achieved 140 days without a Days Away Case.
- Total Recordable Incident Rate= 0.31
- All Safety and Environment Enhancement Plan (SEEP) targets delivered
- 98% of non-hazardous non-radiological waste recycled

- ILW Store foundations and pile caps
- Physical works to support periodic safety review
- Reactor Safestore programme
- 2yr Research and Development programme on the legacy waste vaults

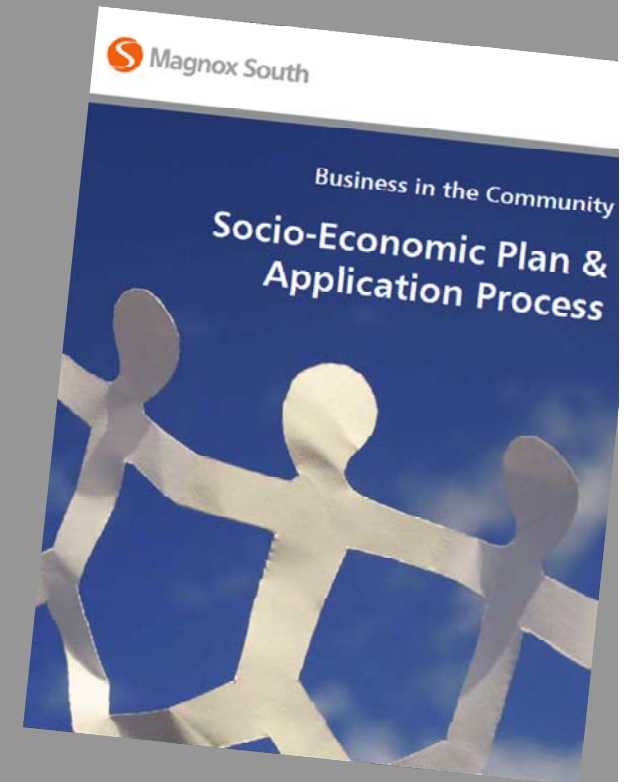


Restructuring
